Lesson Text: John 20:24-29. Some Will Not Believe Unless....

I. Unless They See A Sign, They Will Not Believe.

- Matthew 12:38-40; 41-42.
- 1 Corinthians 1:21-24.
- Do People Today Wait On A Sign?
 - Some Try To Justify It By Signs Given To Moses, Gideon, & David.
 - Exodus 33:12-23; Judges 6:36-40; Psalm 86:17.
 - Today, Many Still Believe In The Signs Of Mark 16:17-18.
 - Some Are Waiting For The Signs Of Matthew 24:4-44, To Then Believe.

II. Unless They Have More Evidence, They Will Not Believe.

- Many An Atheist & Agnostics Say They Would Believe, If They Could Only See God.
- They Say There Is No Real Empirical Evidence For:
 - 1. Creation. 2. God. 3. Jesus. 4. The Holy Spirit. 5. Heaven. 6. Hell. 7. The Devil.
- To Them, "We Walk By Faith, Not By Sight" (2 Corinthians 5:7), Doesn't Make Sense.
 - They Are More Like Thomas, Who Had To See Before He Believed. John 20:29.
- The Scriptures Are Not Enough Evidence For Them— They Reject God's Word!
 - But The Eyewitness Testimony Of Inspired Men Is Not Enough For Them!
 - John 20:30-31; Luke 16:27-31.
- They Also Reject The Evidence Of Design Demands A Designer! (A Scientific Fact).
 - Psalm 19:1-6; Psalm 139:13-14.

III. Unless The Majority Believes It, They Will Not Believe.

- Some Base The Most Important Decisions Of Life On What Others Believe!
 - This Becomes An Unspoken Form Of Peer Pressure To Conform To The World's Beliefs.
 - Romans 12:2.
- The Majority Has Never Been For God's Ways! Matthew 7:13-14; Luke 13:23-24.
 - Would Noah Have Been Saved By Listening To The Majority? 1 Peter 3:20.
- The Only Majority We Should Strive To Be In Is Those Of Faith In Hebrews 11-12:1.
- We Should Have Our Own Mind Choose Faith Over Fear Of What Others Might Think!

IV. Unless It Is A Convenient Season, I Will Not Believe.

- Acts 24:24-27.
- There Is No Convenient Season— A Myth The Devil Uses To Keep Us!
- Felix May Thought There Would Be An Easier Time To Stop Sinning Later On!
- Sin Is Not Easy To Give Up, But We Must! Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30-31.
