- Unlike The Jews of His Day Who Stayed Away From The Sick Luke 7:39; 19:7.
- Can We Ever Help The Sick Without Having Contact With Them?
- Jesus Is The Only Qualified And Capable Physician No Not One! (Song).

II. Jesus Helps Us With All Our Sicknesses.

- Heart Problems: Mark 10:5; Luke 24:25; Acts 28:27; Rom. 2:5; Heb. 3:12.
- Eye Problems: John 9:39-41; 2 Peter 1:9; Matthew 6:22-23.
- Hand Problems: Psalm 26:10; Proverbs 6:17; Matthew 5:30.
- Foot Problems: Proverbs 6:18; Jeremiah 14:10; Mark 9:45.
- Hearing Problems: Matthew 13:15; Acts 7:57; Heb. 5:11; 2 Tim. 4:3-4.
- Sin Sickness: Compared To Leprosy... 2 Kings 5- John 3:3-5; Titus 3:4-7.
- But It Up To Us To Seek The Help Of The Great Physician!
