"The Dangers of Worldliness To Our Faith"

Lesson Text: 1 John 2:15-17

I. God Warns Us Of This Danger.

- Avoid it 1 Timothy 6:20; 2 Timothy 2:16.
- Don't Be "Conformed to this World" Romans 12:1-2.
- Remain "unspotted from the world" James 1:27.
- Deny "ungodly and worldly lusts" Titus 2:11-12.
- The "worldly minded" won't be saved Philippians 3:18-19.

II. What Is Worldliness?

- A. Thayer defines the "World" (Kosmos) "Primarily order, arrangement."
- I. The circle of the Earth (Gen. 1:1).
- 2. The inhabitants of the Earth, men, the human race." (John 3:16).
- 3. The ungodly multitude; the whole mass of men alienated from God and therefore hostile to God. (*I John 5:19*).
- 4. Worldly affairs; the aggregate of things earthly; the circle of earthly goods, endowments, riches, advantages, pleasures, etc., which, although hollow and frail and fleeting, stir desire, seduce from God and are obstacles to the cause of Christ (*Matt.* 13:22).
 - **B.** All sin is worldliness.
 - The works of the flesh **Galatians 5:19-21**.

Pornography, immodest dress, vulgar speech, sexual immorality, lying, murder, drunkenness, recreational drugs, lewd dancing, and anything that promotes lust...

2 Peter 1:4; Ephesians 2:1-6.

- Any thought, attitude, or action hostile to God or His ways Luke 12:19.
- C. The more insidious form of worldliness is "the cares of this world."

 Matthew 13:22; Mark 4:19. Includes even non-sinful things....

III. Why Worldliness Is A Problem.

- A. We Lose Our Distinctiveness & Moral Purity.
 - 2 Corinthians 6:17-18; Ephesians 5:8-11.
- **B.** It Causes Us To Be Unfruitful in the Kingdom Work.

Mark 4:19; John 15:1-8.

- C. It Blinds Us To Our Duties To God.
 - Luke 12:15-21; Luke 14:16-20.
- D. It Hinders & Stunts Our Growth As A Christian.
 - 2 Peter 3:18; Ephesians 5:15-17; 2 Peter 1:5-8.
- E. It Can Lead Us Away From God.
 - 2 Peter 3:17; 2 Timothy 4:10 (See 1 John 2:15-17 again).
