- But Rather, Being Fully Devoted To The Lord- 1 Kings 8:54-61; Acts 2:41-42 (NASB).
- We Give Our Whole Being To The Lord- Romans 12:1-2.
  - Give The Lord Our Heart- Psalm 9:1 Or Mark 7:6.
  - Give The Lord Our Ears- Matthew 13:41-43; James 1:19-21 Or Proverbs 28:9.
  - Give The Lord Our Hands- Ecclesiastes 9:10; Isaiah 59:3 Or 21 Timothy 2:8.
  - Give The Lord Our Mouth- 1 Peter 3:10 Or Psalm 10:4-7.
  - Give The Lord Our Feet- **Ephesians 6:15** Or **Proverbs 6:18.**
  - We Give The Lord Our Time- Ephesians 5:15-16 Or Acts 17:21.
  - We Give The Lord Our Service- 2 Corinthians 12:15 Or Matthew 25:18.

- We More Likely To Give In To Sin- Acts 5:1-5.
- Our Knowledge Of The Lord Will Be Less Than It Should Be- Matthew 13:13-17.
- We Will Not Bear Much Fruit For The Lord- Matthew 13:22; John 15:4.

- We Are More Likely To Resist Sin- John 14:24.
- Our Knowledge Of The Lord Will Be Increased- 1 Timothy 4:15-16.
