- But Rather, Being Fully Devoted To The Lord- **1 Kings 8:54-61; Acts 2:41-42 (NASB).**
- We Give Our Whole Being To The Lord- **Romans 12:1-2.**
 - Give The Lord Our Heart- **Psalm 9:1 Or Mark 7:6.**
 - Give The Lord Our Ears- **Matthew 13:41-43; James 1:19-21 Or Proverbs 28:9.**
 - Give The Lord Our Hands- **Ecclesiastes 9:10; Isaiah 59:3 Or 21 Timothy 2:8.**
 - Give The Lord Our Mouth- **1 Peter 3:10 Or Psalm 10:4-7.**
 - Give The Lord Our Feet- **Ephesians 6:15 Or Proverbs 6:18.**
 - We Give The Lord Our Time- **Ephesians 5:15-16 Or Acts 17:21.**
 - We Give The Lord Our Service- **2 Corinthians 12:15 Or Matthew 25:18.**

II. What Happens When We Don't....

- We Are Not Able To Make Sacrifices For The Lord- **Matthew 19:20-22.**
- We More Likely To Give In To Sin- **Acts 5:1-5.**
- Our Knowledge Of The Lord Will Be Less Than It Should Be- **Matthew 13:13-17.**
- We Will Not Bear Much Fruit For The Lord- **Matthew 13:22; John 15:4.**

III. What Happens When We Do....

- We Are Able To Make Sacrifices For The Lord- **Matthew 13:44.**
- We Are More Likely To Resist Sin- **John 14:24.**
- Our Knowledge Of The Lord Will Be Increased- **1 Timothy 4:15-16.**
- We Will Bear Much Fruit For The Lord- **Matthew 13:23.**
