I. Neglect Is Dangerous Because It Requires No Effort.

- Definition of Neglect: to not give enough care or attention to people or things that are your responsibility: Neglect To Do Something. (Cambridge Dictionary) (Fail to do something).

II. Neglect Is Dangerous Because Of Its Destructive Nature.

III. Neglect Is Dangerous Because Of Its Deceptive Nature.

- Many Will Argue That Murder, Genocide, Adultery, Fornication, And Stealing Are Some Of The Worst Sins. But It Is True That All Sin Condemns! 1 John 3:4; Romans 6:23.
- The Most Dangerous Sin Is The One We Don't See As Sin- Neglect.
- That's The Deceptive Nature Of Neglect, We Overlook or Excuse It Hebrews 3:13.
- When We Get Selective On What We Will And Will Not Do In God's Will Feel Safe.
